




Who are Pell Grant Recipients?

Students who demonstrate "extreme" financial need


Nearly All Pell Grant Recipients Come From Families With Incomes of \$60,000 or Less


2003, 16%: "We Enroll More Pell Grant Recipients"


2008, 11%: Oberlin Rises to the "Challenge"





2009, 14%: Oberlin Rises to the "Challenge"




2015, 10%: "Least Financially Accessible Among Peers"


2023, 9%: Oberlin's "Dreadful Placement at the Bottom"



\$5M Gift Supports Oberlin Business Programs and Curriculum

"The \$5 million gift is contingent on raising an additional \$5 million, as the goal is to encourage other donors to support an expanded business program at Oberlin.
